PUBLIC AIRWAVES PHILOSOPHY

KSDP believes that the airwaves, especially those controlled by a public radio station, should be used in a way that benefits the communities we service. The programming of our station should, whenever possible, reflect the needs and desires of our listeners.

It is important for every cultural, gender-based, age-based and religious group to have free access to the public airwaves that have been licensed, under the authority of the United States Congress, to KSDP. This station believes in giving every person an opportunity to harness the power of radio to communicate their message to our audience.

It is with that aim that the following policy is written and adopted.

- It is first and foremost the priority of KSDP to provide news, weather and information that directly enhances the safety and quality of life of those we serve.
- KSDP will not block access to its airwaves based on race, gender, religious affiliation, sexual orientation or physical handicap. Management reserves the right limit access to persons under the age of 21.
- Content aired on KSDP must be within acceptable community standards for broadcast. Inflammatory or lewd comments, either spoken or in song, are not permitted.
- KSDP will provide reasonable access to any person seeking use of KSDP's frequency. This includes basic training on the operation of KSDP's equipment.
- Groups or persons using KSDP's frequency and facilities may be held financially responsible for any damage caused as a result of their use.
- Management reserves the right to require the airing of a disclaimer prior to any programming that is aired by any group or person.
- Groups or persons using KSDP's facilities are expected to adhere to all KSDP policies, as outlined in the KSDP Policy Manual.
- Groups or persons may have their privileges suspended or revoked for violating any of the above conditions.
- Groups or persons may appeal any decision made by KSDP management to the Board of Directors of Aleutian Peninsula Broadcasting, Inc.. Appeals will be handled during regular business meetings, unless such a delay would endanger public health and safety or cause great harm to the person or group.
